Team Yukon Uniforms

The official Team Yukon uniform is: red-black team shirts purchased from Team Yukon and black pants, shorts or skirt (provided by you)

- ✚ All Team Yukon participants **AND** non-participants **MUST** have a team shirt to wear in the parade and at opening and closing ceremonies.
- ✚ Orders can be placed at the Team Information meeting on March 2024.
- ✚ The cost of a shirt is estimated to be \$50. **ERA is not able to subsidize uniforms costs.**
- ✚ OPTIONAL Items include a jacket (~\$60) and cap (~\$20), and details will be provided at the March meeting.

Team Yukon Accommodations

- ✚ A Team Yukon block booking has been secured at the Plaza hotel in Quebec City. More information will be provided at the **March 2024 Information Meeting**.
- ✚ Rooms will be based on a minimum double occupancy and there may be rooms that could accommodate 4 people sharing. We need to know if you will require Team Yukon hotel accommodation and with whom you would like to share a room.
- ✚ In addition to hotels, camping will be available for those who want to drive and stay in a campground. You make your own camping arrangements.

Any accommodation subsidy will be dependent on the ERA budget and the number of Team Yukon participants.
